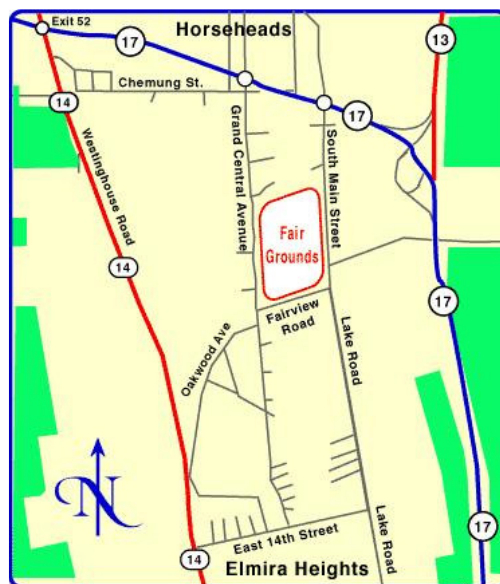

General Information

1. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rulebook will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
2. **STABLING: PERMANENT BOX STALLS WITH DOORS ARE AVAILABLE FOR \$50.00.** Request all stalls on entry blank. Stall fees must accompany reservations. **NO REFUNDS ON STALLS.** Initial bedding is not included but may be purchased on the fairgrounds. Please send check and order form in with your entries.
3. **CAMPERS:** There will be a 75.00 fee for camper hook ups.
4. All Welsh ponies six years & over showing in breeding classes and all Welsh and half Welsh ponies showing in WPCSA performance classes must be measured or present a valid USEF or WPCSA measurement card. All ponies and cobs showing USEF days must show current measurement cards or be measured at the show. Officials will be measuring on Saturday & Sunday from 8:00 am until 9:00 am
5. All classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted. All Prize money will be paid in the ring. Six ribbons will be awarded in all classes unless otherwise stated.
6. There will be a \$30.00 surcharge added to all checks returned by the bank. All entries not paid in full at the show will be charged a \$25.00 billing fee.
7. All Welsh animals must be registered in the stud books of the Welsh Pony & Cob Society of America, Inc., or the Welsh Pony & Cob Society of Canada and must be entered under their full registered name, or if under one year, be eligible for registration.
8. Before numbers will be issued Exhibitors must provide a negative Coggins test for each entry. Animals stabled in New York State must present a negative certificate dated either 2009 or 2010. Animals stabled outside New York State must present a negative certificate dated since May 3, 2009 Proof of Rabies inoculation between May 3, 2009 and April 30, 2010 must also be presented for each entry.
9. Kelviden Farm and the show manager take no responsibility for loss, injury or damage to animals, exhibitors, equipment and anyone connected thereto.
10. Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.
11. **Junior exhibitors must wear approved protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) at all times whenever mounted or in a driven vehicle at all times while on the show ground. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.**
12. **ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASHES OR TIED IN A STALL AT ALL TIMES.**
13. **ENTRIES CLOSE April 23, 2010. Once an animal is entered in at least one class, post entries will be accepted at the regular fee.** Post Entries accepted for new animals for an additional \$5.00/class above the regular entry fee.
14. All fees will be refunded if entries are cancelled on or before April 22, 2010. There will be a \$25 office charge for all scratches after April 23, 2010. There will be no refunds on stalls. Once the show has started horses that are not shown in classes in which they are entered forfeit their entry fee except if a horse is injured or becomes ill. Proper notification by a veterinarian and a scratch sheet must be presented to the office prior to the start of the class being scratched.
15. Outdoor ring is 120' x 240" and the Indoor ring is 80' x 200' and the footing is sand.
16. **Motorized Vehicle Statement** In accordance with GR1301.7: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Breed Classes

Entry Fee: \$25.00 per class

Animals are to be shown in hand at a walk and a trot except in group classes. To be judged 85% on breed type, conformation, way of going, quality and substance and 15% on disposition and manners. Natural reaching action is desired. Appropriate attire is required.

Classes will happily be further split and championships awarded if at least three ponies are entered in any given class. Just email and ask if you want to be sure a class will be split before you come! (Kelviden@yahoo.com) My goal is to help get you as many points as possible!

WPCSA RIDDEN WELSH CLASSICS *Entry Fee: \$25.00*

These classes are for registered Welsh 4 years of age and over. To be judged 50% on performance and 50% on conformation. Class is an English class only. No Western, Saddle Seat or Side Saddle tack or attire. To be shown at the walk, trot, canter and gallop, on both reins as a group, displaying Welsh movement as described in the breed description. An individual performance showing all four gaits in both directions by each participant will be required (the gallop need only be shown in one direction). Each animal will then be stripped for conformation judging. Once an entry has been judged for conformation it may be retacked. UK Judge or qualified American Judge to officiate.

WPCSA BEST RIDDEN AND RESERVE BEST RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP (Article 115.9) ***.

To be judged 50% on conformation and 50% on ridden performance. Open to first and second placed winners from the Ridden Welsh A/B Classic and the Ridden Welsh C/D Classic. There is no entry fee for this class. This is an English class only. No Western, Saddleseat or Side Saddle tack or attire. Places will be awarded for the Best Ridden and the Best Ridden Reserve. Any animal in this class is eligible to be named the Best Ridden. Entries shall enter the arena at a walk in a clockwise direction. The Judge shall request all four gaits (walk, trot, canter, gallop) in at least one direction, but animals need not show in both directions. The judge shall consider the size of the ponies/cobs, ages of riders, safety of arena when determining whether to have the animals perform as a group or individually. Individual pattern is optional at the judge's discretion. Entries shall not be stripped as conformation score from the qualifying class shall be carried forward.

Driving Divisions

Removing the bridle from an animal harnessed to a vehicle, or leaving an animal unattended while hitched, anywhere on the show grounds, will result in instant elimination and removal from the show grounds.

Pleasure Driving Divisions

To be shown to a suitable two or four-wheeled vehicle, but not a viceroy, racing sulky or Fine Harness rig. To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, working trot and trot on and stand quietly and, except for tandems, to back readily. Conformation classes to be judged 75% on performance, manners, movement and style, and 25% on breed type and conformation. Working classes to be judged 100% on performance.

Turnout to be judged 70% on the condition, fit and appropriateness of harness and vehicle, neatness and appropriateness of attire and overall impression, 30% on performance, manners and way of going. Working class to be judged 70% on performance, manners and way of going; 20% on condition and fit of harness and vehicle; 10% on neatness of attire.

Under Saddle Classes: To be shown at a walk, trot & canter both ways of the ring. A maximum of eight animals may be asked to hand gallop one way of the ring. To be judged 75% on performance, manners and style, and 25% on breed type and conformation. When judging half-Welsh, Breed type is not considered. Exhibitors must complete at least one over fence class to be eligible for the Under Saddle class except in the unrated open classes, where entries may enter the under saddle class without jumping..

83. WPCSA WALK-TROT (Article 115.5) Classes open to riders 11 & under mounted on ponies/cobs/half-Welsh. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. To walk and trot/jog both ways of the ring. Possible test to include: walk, trot/jog, turn, halt and rein back at spots marked. English or Western attire is acceptable. Riders ineligible for other ridden classes except leading rein, child's first pony, walk-trot, walk-trot poles.

84. WPCSA WALK-TROT POLES(Article 115.5) Classes open to riders 11 & under mounted on ponies/cobs/half-Welsh. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. To be ridden once around a course of four poles on the ground entirely at a walk or entirely at a trot or jog. Poles are to be placed a minimum of four feet off the rail, two on each side of the ring, simulating a hunter course. The poles should be placed far enough away from the entrance gate to provide an adequate sized area to do an opening and closing circle. May be ridden at either a walk or trot. English or Western attire is acceptable. Riders ineligible for other ridden classes except leading rein, child's first pony, walk-trot, walk-trot poles.

85. WPCSA CHILD'S FIRST PONY (Article 115.2) Section A, B, C and Half-Welsh, mare or gelding 12.2 hands and under, to be ridden by junior exhibitors at least four, but not more than 10, years of age. Riders to be suitably dressed in Hunt, Saddle or Western attire including protective headgear. Ponies to be shown at a walk and trot or jog, both ways of the ring. 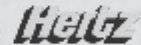
